A first look at the new Corgi models for July to December 2012

Corgi has just announced its next wave of new models, scheduled for release from July to the end of this year.

We're mainly focusing here on the new and modified tooling, new liveries and special editions.

In the Aviation Archive range, for example, we can look forward to the 1:72 Hawker Audax - a dedicated army co-operation aircraft developed in the early 1930s from the already proven Hawker Hart light day bomber (already available in the range and which featured as our Model of the Month in the April 2012 issue).

To celebrate the 50th anniversary of the MGB, new 1:43 Vanguards tooling will serve to create a special set, featuring the first and last MGBs

New moving floor trailer tooling will feature in the Hauliers of Renown range, where it's also nice to see some more 1:50 British spec truck models from the 1970s appearing.

Due to the production problems in China that have affected so many of our model manufacturers, a number of items previously announced but regrettably delayed have had to be

carried over into the new catalogue. In such instances, we thought you'd like a peek at how things are progressing, so we've also included pics of updated samples that are now nearing the final production stage.

Please note that all the models shown in this preview feature are pre-production samples, so slight

modifications may still be made to some of them before they actually go on sale. **Please also note that the scheduled release dates published may be subject to change.** We look forward, as always, to hearing your comments on the new line-up. **MC**

There will also be new 1:43 Vauxhall tooling, in the form of the fiercely fast hot-hatch Astra Mk 2 GTE and the third generation Cavalier - this Mk 3 SRi will initially be released in Carmine Red but will also be detailed and liveried as Merseyside Police issue. Please note though, pre-production samples of these two Vauxhalls are not yet available for photography, so in this report we've simply included rendered images for illustration purposes.

007 fans can look forward to a new 1:36 DB5 to tie in with the 50th anniversary of the first ever Bond film and the next film in the series, Skyfall, due for release later this year.
